
Notice of Proposed Permit Issuance and Public Meeting

Notice is given in accordance with Chapter 551, Government Code and Texas Water Code Section 36.404 that the Pecan Valley GCD Board of Directors will hold a public meeting on April 20, 2026 at 9:00 a.m. at the District Office, located at 1009 N. Esplanade St., Cuero, TX. The purpose of the meeting is to conduct regular District business and hear public comment and consider possible issuance on the following permit application.

Operating Permit Amendment Application from Burlington Resources on Lackey Land Limited property. The application is for the beneficial use for Mining Oil and Gas purposes and requests an increased annual production from 10 acre-feet to 50 acre-feet of water from this water well. This property is located on St. Hwy 119 N. near Yorktown and involves 1,354.68 acres.

Any person who intends to contest a permit application must provide written notice to the district at 1009 N. Esplanade, Cuero, Texas 77954, at least three business days prior to the proposed date of issuance and include all requested information in District Rule 15.5.1 (a-c).
